# Why Does Prayer Heal Diseases?

*Jesus healed came into Peter's house, he saw Peter's mother-in-law lying in bed with a fever. He touched her hand and the fever left her, and she got up and began to wait on him. When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to him, and he drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick.*

*This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: "He took up our infirmities and carried our diseases."*

**Mt 8:14-17**

Jesus healed the sick and proclaimed the gospel. The apostles and the saints of the early church also ministered in the same way, healing and proclaiming. Jesus gave us a clear promise in Mark 16:15-20.

1. In the Bible, there are promises of healing.

- 1) Mark 6:56 says, "all who touched him were healed."
- 2) Mt 8:17 says, "He took up our infirmities and carried our diseases."
- 3) In Isa 53:5, God promises, "By his wounds we are healed."

2. First, we must diagnose the cause of the disease.

- 1) Some diseases are caused by fatigue (overworked), mistakes, infections or aging.
- 2) The Bible reveals three important causes of disease that cannot be healed by human means, but only by spiritual healing.
  - (1) Diseases caused by sin
    - a. Sins of ancestors: Idol worship is punished to the third and fourth generation (Ex 20:4, 2 Sa 12:15). These unknown diseases cannot be cured by medical treatment.
    - b. Original sin: Because the unsaved are under the curse (from the original sin), healing is impossible (Ge 3:16-19). Temporary healing may be possible, but complete healing is impossible.
    - c. Actual sin: (s Kgs 5:27, 2 Chr 21:12-19, 1 Chr 5:5)
  - (2) Diseases caused by Satan (evil spirits)
    - a. mind (Mk 5:3-15)
    - b. heart (Eph 4:23-27)
    - c. situation (Mt 12:25-28)
    - d. nervous system (Mk 9:17, Lk 13:16)
  - (3) Diseases within God's will (2 Cor 12:7, Dan 8:27)

3. The wrong treatment makes the (above) diseases worse.

- 1) Treatment based only on medical care and medicine
- 2) Treatment that only looks at the physical results
- 3) Treatment based on idols, gods, false religions

4. We need to know the right order of healing.

- 1) Spiritual healing comes first (1 Jn 1:2).
  - (1) Acceptance (Jn 1:12)
  - (2) Fullness of the Holy Spirit (Eph 5:18)
- 2) We must cut off sin (Jas 5:13-16).
- 3) We must purify our environment/situation (Mt 12:25-29).
- 4) Medical treatment should be used only after these steps (Jas 5:13-14).

5. What we do after the healing is also important.

- 1) We must continue performing acts of faith.
- 2) We must recover a thankful attitude.
- 3) We must testify about God's goodness.
