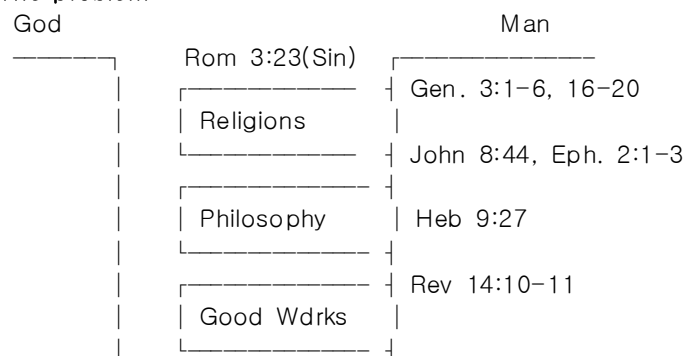

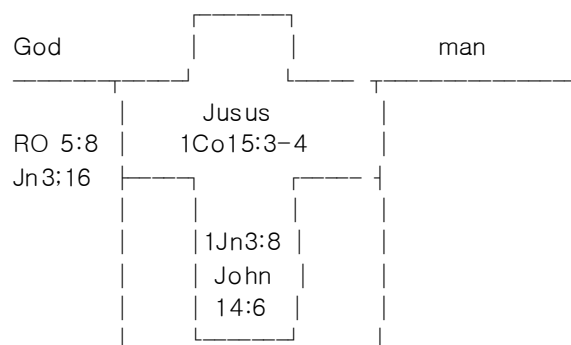

Salvation means freedom from the fundamental problem, which we cannot solve on our own.

- (1) Solve past problems (Eph. 2:1)
- (2) Solve present problems (Eph. 2:2)
- (3) Solve future problem (Eph. 2:6)

3. The Gospel

Christianity's gospel is the good news of Jesus Christ, whose death and resurrection resolved mankind's fundamental problem of sin and death.(1Cor. 15:1 ~ 4)

- 1) The content of the gospel – the death and resurrection of Christ.
- 2) The death of Christ – the ransom of death that solved mankind's problem of sin.

5. God's child

and have their name entered into heaven's registry, the book of life.

7. The Assurance of Salvation

I confirm the fact that I have received salvation by confessing my sin of unbelief before God and accepting Jesus as my Lord and Savior.

- 2) although I physically live in this world, I know my spirit is already a citizen of heaven, and
- 3) my name is entered into Heaven's registry, the Book of Life.

Lec. 4 The Evidence of Rebirth (1Jn. 5:1 ~]3)

The moment you believe with your heart and confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord, God creates a new eternal life in you through the power of the Holy Spirit. This is a spiritual event where you are reborn as God's child. You can't see this with your eyes or feel this with your skin, but new life begins to stir within you the moment you receive Jesus as your Lord and Savior.

1. The result of being born again.

2. The evidence of rebirth.

 - ① external evidence—evidence of the word
 - ① internal evidence—evidence of the Holy Spirit
- (4) Gain assurance of answer to prayer (1Jn. 5:14 ~ 15)
- (5) Try to live a clean and holy life (1Jn. 5:18)
- (6) Overcome the world through faith (1Jn. 5:4)

This life does not happen overnight. We gradually change through the work of the Holy Spirit. Change absolutely takes place in the person who is born again. If there is no change in your life, reconfirm your salvation. If you have not experienced salvation or do not have assurance of salvation, accept Jesus Christ now. Believe with your heart and confess with your mouth, then you will receive eternal life and experience the evidence of rebirth.

When the Israelites, who had been slaves, came out of Egypt and crossed the Red Sea, all their sufferings from Egypt ended. They no longer needed to worry about their past sufferings in Egypt. However, they faced new hardships. This was because they had to go to Canaan. In order to enjoy the blessings in that land, they had to endure these new hardships as training and discipline. Therefore we must persevere and overcome these hardships by faith. After we become Christians, we face these kinds of hardships that result in new conflicts. We must challenge these new conflicts with faith.

1. New conflicts

2. The believer's existence

*Prayer is a spiritual science.

Prayer is simply communicating with God. As God's children, we can confidently approach the throne of grace. Through prayer, we can share our thoughts with God, experience God's power, have victory in spiritual battle, and even fulfill God's will. Therefore only those who have become God's children through Christ can lift up true prayer.

1. Why should we pray?

- (1) To fellowship with God
- (2) To glorify God (Jn. 14:13)
- (3) To mature spiritually
- (4) To fulfill God's plan
- (5) To make known my wishes (Phil. 4:6 ~ 7)

2. When should we pray?

- (1) Need an attitude of praying unceasingly (1Thes. 5:17).

- (3) Gather as a group to pray (Mt. 18:19 ~ 20).

3. The content of prayer – what should we pray?

Just as we have five fingers, there are five elements of prayer. If we use these as guide posts, we can maintain a balanced life of prayer.

- (1) Adoration – 1Chron. 29:10 ~ 11
- (2) Confession – 1Jn 1:9, Ps. 32:5
- (3) Thanksgiving – Eph. 5:20, Ps. 100:4
(Thanksgiving is giving thanks for the things I may not be thankful for.)
- (4) Intercession – Eph. 6:18, Col. 4:2 ~ 4, Jms. 5:16, 1Tim. 2:2
- (5) Supplication – Mt. 7:7 ~ 8, Jn. 15:7

4. How can we pray with assurance?

God does not request great faith from us. All we have to do is simply have faith in a great God.

- (1) Remain in the word (Jn. 15:7).
- (2) Ask in the Lord's name (Jn. 14:14, 16:24).
- (3) Ask with faith (Mt. 21:22).

When you confess and receive Jesus, as a child of God, you become a member of the church, the body of Christ, and you build up that body by doing your part. As a member of the community of the church, God wants you to mature in your spiritual life.

1. The meaning of the church

Originally the church did not refer to a building or an organization but to the congregation of God's chosen people.

(1) The church set up by Jesus (Mt. 16:18).

(2) Jesus Christ's church

- ① Universal, invisible church – unified church with Christ as its head (Eph. 1:22 ~ 23)
- ② Local church – gathering of believers in a fixed region (Acts 11:25 ~ 26, Gal. 1:2 ~ 3)
- ③ Home church – church that formed in the believers' homes during the persecutions that arose in the time of the first century church (1Cor. 16:19, Col. 4:15)

2. The function of the church

(1) Spiritual structure : Christian = natural man + Holy Spirit

Christ's church = multitude + Holy Spirit

(2) The church's 4 functions: worship, evangelism, nurture, serve

- ① Worship – the most important reason the church meets is that those who have been saved by God's grace can gather to worship God.
(Rom. 12:1, Jn. 4:24, Mt. 22:37 ~ 38)
- ② Evangelism – the church must fulfill both functions of gathering to worship and going out to proclaim the gospel.
 - a) evangelize according to God's method of salvation (1Cor. 1:21).
 - b) the Lord's Great Commission (Mt. 28:19 ~ 20)
 - c) Irresistible duty (1Cor. 9:16)
- ③ Nurture – the church must faithfully nurture the new believer to grow to maturity.
(1Tim. 4:12 ~ 13, Rom. 12:6 ~ 8, Eph. 4:12)
- ④ Serve – the church must nurture and teach the new believer to mature into a worker who serves. (Gal. 6:9 ~ 10)
 - a) workers of Christ (1Cor. 4:1)
 - b) Jesus' example (Jn. 13:14)
 - c) steward's service (1Pet. 4:10)

3. The duty of the church

Jesus Christ's church must perform the duties of the church entrusted to it.

(1) Guardian of truth (1Tim. 3:15)

(2) Christ's proxy (Mt. 25:40)

(3) World missions (Jn 20:21, Mk. 16:15)

1. Promise concerning prayer.

Mt. 21:21 ~ 22, Lk. 11:13, Lk. 18:7 ~ 8, Jn. 14:13 ~ 14, 15:7, 15:16, 16:23 ~ 24

2. Prayer is a spiritual science.

(1) When we pray, the Spirit comes upon us.

(2) When we pray, God's heralds (angel) are mobilized.

(4) Together with other people of prayer

※Failure in prayer results in failure in your spiritual life. (Calvin)

Worship is the most important aspect of the Christian life. It is the creation, mankind, worshipping the creator, the triune God.

1. The object of worship

Even now many people are serving lifeless wooden and stone idols.

They also serve worldly idols such as money, power, and science.

However these things are merely a part of God's creation.

What is our object of worship? (Rev. 4:8, 4:11, 5:9, 12~13)

2. The right attitude of worship

Worship means to direct the focus of our hearts to God in holiness and sincerity.

God blesses those who offer true worship. (John 4:20~24 Ecc. 5:1~2)

3. The content of worship

There are many steps in the content of worship, but we will focus on the following important 4:

(1) Praise (Heb. 13:15)

Sacrifice of praise—expressing thanksgiving, repentance, prayer, and testimony through song

(2) Prayer (Rev. 5:8, 8:3~4)

Golden bowls filled with incense—expressing thanksgiving, confession, supplication, and intercession through words

(3) Scripture (Ps. 78:1, Neh. 8:5~9)

Listening intently to God's word and reaffirming our will to obey

(4) Offering (Prov. 3:9~10, Matt. 6:21, Mai. 3:10~12)

With thanks, offering back to God what is rightfully His through—tithe, offering, thanksgiving offering, missions offering etc.

4. Types of worship

(1) Main service—formal worship offered by the gathered community of believers

① Sunday morning service

② Sunday evening service

③ Wednesday night service

(2) Other services—worship other than the main service: family, district, dawn, late night service, ...etc.

5. To offer proper worship

(1) Promptness—prepare in advance in order to be on time

(2) Attitude—properly and virtuously

(3) Seating—orderly begin with the front seat

(4) Sincerity—worship with all your mind and will

(5) Memorize the Apostle's Creed and the Lord's Prayer in advance

The Bible is the collection of God's inspired writings, taken from about 40 different authors over 1500 years. The purpose the Bible was written is to serve as a guide that reveals the knowledge of God's salvation and a life of dwelling with God, not as an educational or academic tool.

2. The Bible is God's word

- (1) 1Tim. 3:16 inspired by God (God-breathed)

※ The 39 books of the Old Testament are the words that Moses and the prophets received from God. The 27 books of the New Testament are the collection of God inspired records and apostle's epistles (letters).

3. The outline of the Bible

- (1) God's word and the creation of man

- (3) God calls Abraham to reveal Himself to fallen man
- (4) Makes a covenant with Israel, speaks through their history
- (5) Reveals Himself through Jesus and payed the ransom through the cross

4. Why we need to read the Bible.

*To learn and assurance

- (1) Knowledge of salvation

1. Character of the Bible

- (1) The Bible is God's word (2Tim. 3:16).

The Bible is God's inspired word that He gave to man,
through the prophets or apostles, as our guide post to life.

- (2) The Bible is prophecy (Rev. 1:3).

Because the events of the future are accurately recorded in the Bible,
we will face calamity if we don't know what has been recorded.

- (3) The Bible is an eternal promise (Is. 40:8).

Because God is eternal, His promise, the Bible, is true and eternal.

① The Bible is God's given method (2Pet. 1:21).

② The Bible's superiority (2Cor. 2:13).

- (4) The Bible will be accomplished on this earth (Mt. 5:17 ~ 18).

- (5) No one can change the Bible. Anyone who tries will be condemned.

(Deut. 4:2, Rev. 22:18 ~ 19).

- (6) The Bible leads us in lighted paths and firmly builds us up (Ps. 119:105, Acts 20:32).

- (7) The Bible reveals God's will to us and is the weapon that overcomes Satan's power

(Mt. 4:4, 7, 10).

2. Content of the Bible

What is the theme of the Bible?

- (1) Warns us of the fact that we were tricked by Satan,

became ignorant of God, and as a sinner we are headed for hell (Gen. 3:15, Eph. 2:1 ~ 3).

- (2) Promises us salvation if we believe in the coming Messiah (Gen. 3:15, Jn. 8:56).

- (3) The New Testament is—the evidence that the Messiah,

of whom the Old Testament made over 400 references, has come (Is. 7:14, Mt. 1:21).

- (4) Promises us the indwelling and guidance of the Holy Spirit to those accept Jesus

(Jn. 14:16, 26, Rom. 8:2).

3. Purpose of learning the Bible

4. Way to understand the Bible (Ps. 119:11)

1. The reason why failure continues to come.

- (1) Because you don't have the complete conclusion of Christ.

1. You will be victorious if you come out of your "religious" surroundings.

- (1) Ideology of church authority (politics) (Jn. 3:1 ~ 12)
- (2) Legalism
- (3) Philanthropy, pietism, and zealously that is ahead of the gospel
- (4) Positive thinking, negative (passive) thinking

2. You will be victorious if you come out of your idolatrous surroundings.

- (1) Graven image (Ex. 20:4 ~ 5)
- (2) Idol of ideology (Pharisee's ideology, family creed)
- (3) Idol of church politics (Organization oriented rather than oriented on the gospel or the Bible)
- (4) Idol of religion (Pietism rather than the gospel)

3. You will be victorious if you come out of demonic activities.

- (1) Ancestral worship (1Cor. 10:20)
- (2) Offering sacrifices to spirits for good luck
- (3) Divination, fortunetelling, superstition
- (4) Tarot writing (good luck writings)
- (5) Particular images, pictures, photographs

Come out of the things you have idolized.

4. Environmental healing (Mt. 12:25 ~ 45)

- (1) Quarrels
- (2) Conflicts
- (3) Emptiness

Mental healing is the most normal healing.

There are a few things that the patient himself and his family must remember.

1, Receive continuous healing through the word from the pulpit.

2. Receive continuous healing through the words from the healing minister.

- (1) Environment – Family, Darakbang, Mission Home, Specialized Ministry, Healing Ministry
- (2) Regulation of the physical body.

4. Receive healing for adjustment

- (1) A committed worker must come out from among the family member.
- (2) Receive healing for adjustment through the Healing Ministry Clinic.
- (3) Receive healing for adjustment through the family.

- (1) Root cause of the problem (Gen. 3:1 ~ 20)
